Town of Normal Parks and Recreation Shelter Rentals

Normal, IL – February 26, 2018 – The Town of Normal Parks and Recreation Department has several picnic shelters that can be reserved for a rental fee for reunions, birthday parties, family gatherings and much more. Reservations by individuals or groups are taken beginning the first business day in March at the Parks and Recreation office.

There is a shelter rental fee to reserve the nine (9) shelters currently available. Rental fees are charged for reservations April 15 through October 15 of each year. Park shelters may be reserved between the hours of 9:00am and 9:00pm. Reservations are valid for the entire day.
